Editorial

Filosofía de la Economía (Philosophy of Economics) is a Journal whose main focus is on epistemology and philosophy of economics. Occasionally will be also published papers about philosophical aspects of the history of economic thinking and social sciences, as well as problems concerning philosophy of administration and accounting.

Economics is an extraordinary attractive subject for philosophical research. Economic theory has been under discussion for more than two centuries and even if much of the theoretical devices incorporated to economic models show an impressive rigor and sophistication similar to that exhibited by natural sciences, the relevance of its models and theoretical results are still questioned and hotly debated. Particularly it is not well understood the plurality of functions that its models play, its ability to explain and illuminate crucial economic phenomena —like crises-, and its capacity for serving as a base for the implementation of successful economic policies.

Although in the past economics used to "export" its logic to the remaining social sciences, nowadays consciously of its own limitations is beginning to start running in the opposite direction, "importing" concepts from psychology, anthropology, history and neurobiology. Such integrations of different sciences demand the lead of philosophy.

One of the main goals of *Filosofía de la Economía* is to contribute to the discussion of the host of subjects and problems mentioned above. It is a pluralist Journal which encourages the participation of different philosophical views on economics and welcome a multiplicity of approaches —orthodox, heterodox and interdisci- plinary views-, putting just one condition: contributions should comply with high standards of academic quality.
